**V-Volunteering**

Nicole from V-inspired talked to the group about the various awards and advantages they can receive through V-volunteering accreditation scheme. All members of the Youth Council wanted to become part of the scheme. Some will be excluded from the scheme because they are under 16, although you can, in some circumstances, receive accreditation when you are 15yrs old.

Nicole also talked about the Youth Action team, who are a group of young people, who encourage their peers to volunteer. They have recently formed and are working out their objectives.

There is also a V-Cash scheme that all groups can apply for. It gives groups money to organise or carry out events and activities which are of benefit to the general community. The largest award is £2500.

Finally Nicole explained that V Volunteering are developing a new award called 'Impact' to be launched in due course.

**Local Strategic Partnership (LSP)**

Jane Pearce, who co-ordinates the LSP wanted to consult with the group. Jane explained the LSP is key committee of people who devise a community plan for the District. All other committee and groups ensure their plan compliments the LSP plan. There are also representative from all major committees and groups on the LSP board or groups.

The LSP is reviewing (refresh) it's priorities and wants the Youth Council to input. The group agreed to input as a group but consult with other young people. The Youth Council will:

- Organize a Mi-Pod with questions that address young people's needs and feelings about where they live.
- Collate the information and present it to the LSP
- Comment on the priorities as a group.
